<b>Inspection Modifications</b>	Ensure woody brush mats heavily backed into bank, large wood should be embedded > 50% of length of trunk. Construction timeline July 1 - Nov 1 to protect brown trout spawning. Will likely need extension for phase 2 work (2017) or a 2-year permit. Consult with FWP if need work time frame extension.

**Perennial Stream:** West Gallatin River

**Cause of Emergency:** On 6-28 the amount of water flowing in the river past the ditch diversion point had dropped to a trickle and was not supplying the full or even the partial required water rights of the users of the ditch for irrigation of crops. The main river channel splits into 2 channels about 300 yds. above ditch...the channel carrying water to the ditch POD has lost water due to the gravel bar which has developed over time...

**Action Taken:** (Went) to where main channel split and divert water into the channel which passes by the ditch POD. Jim Mize...used his backhoe to divert the water.

**Inspection Recommendation:** Approved as Proposed

**Inspection Comments:** This situation requires chasing the water upstream to keep ditch wet. No obvious alternatives to work done. Potential for similar work next year in same area.
